Description : Native prairie may be dominated by grasses, but these communities also support many different types of grass-like, showy flowers, and shrubs. These plants are important for evaluating the health of our grasslands whether you're interested in managing them as rangelands, for habitat conservation or even for recreation. The ability to identify plant species or groups of plants is a tricky, yet essential skill for the staff in many organizations working with native prairie. The goal of this webinar is to introduce participants to the basic terminology and skills needed to identify some common native prairie plants. To finish off the webinar, we'll test your knowledge with a fun and interactive plant ID quiz!
