Pictures that qualify (ie: are of native prairie) will be uploaded to an Album on Facebook and open to public voting.

Voting: June 15-19<sup>th</sup>, 2026 (ending June 19<sup>th</sup> at 5 PM CST)

The picture in each category with the most votes will receive a prize. Only votes on the uploaded picture in the PCAP official NPAW Photo Contest Album, during this time period will be counted.

The Winners will be announced June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2026.

### Photos will be included based on the following criteria:

- Photos that include crops or farming equipment will be disqualified.

Winners will be announced publicly after Native Prairie Appreciation Week. Prizes will be mailed to winners directly. All Photo **winners** must complete a release form. Winners will be contacted about their prize and release form.
